

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#### **CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

Friends in Christ,

in this Lenten season we have heard our Lord's call to struggle against sin, death, and the devil—all that keeps us from loving God and each other. This is the struggle to which we were called at baptism.

Within the community of the church, God never wearies of forgiving sin and giving the peace of reconciliation. On this night let us confess our sin against God and our neighbor, and enter the celebration of the great Three Days reconciled with God and with one another.

Most merciful God, we confess that we are captive to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen.

God, who is rich in mercy, loved us even when we were dead in sin, and made us alive together with Christ. By grace you have been saved. In the name of + Jesus Christ, your sins are forgiven. Almighty God strengthen you with power through the Holy Spirit, that Christ may live in your hearts through faith. Amen.

- L2) Come, you who will be a living intercession on behalf of those for whom you pray.


## AN INVITATION TO PRAYER AND HEALING



## The Spirit Intercedes For Us

L 1: It is God who justifies, who is to condemn?

It is Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised...

Who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us.

Who will separate us from the love of Christ?

Will hardship, or distress, or persecution?

Will famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

(Romans 8:33-35)

L 2: Will shame or guilt?

Will our doubts and fears?

Will our memories from the past?

Will our anxiety about the future?

## The Spirit Intercedes For Us

- L 1: No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:37-39)
- L 2: What freedom this gives us in prayer;

Trusting that nothing can separate us from the love of God.

We can now pray boldly and persistently...

We can pray silently or wordlessly with the Spirit of Christ praying in us,

Pleading for us, and working through us... to bring Christ's love to birth, to the earth





## THE LORDS PRAYER


